In 1982 a woman named Jackie Lelong saw a clear need to improve the way we serve older adults. In particular, she understood the challenges faced by Family Caregivers who tried to balance the complex needs of an older loved-one with their own professional and family responsibilities. Their health, happiness, and finances suffered without critical support like respite, high quality In Home Care, In-Home Counseling, and other resources. She began a small organization that focused on the whole family. She called it Family Eldercare.

In 2015 we enter our 33rd year of service to Central Texas, and Jackie's vision remains our quiding principle. Through innovative programs like

Money Management, Lifetime Connections Without Walls, and the Summer Fan Drive Outreach Program, we provide safety, dignity and independence to thousands of seniors, adults with disabilities, and their caregivers.

In addition, our Guardianship Program is the epitome of a program driven by community needs. Travis and Williamson Counties needed a program to assist with seniors and adults with disabilities who had become wards of the state. Family Eldercare stepped forward and provided Guardianship Services to 428 wards combined in the two counties in 2015.

We are so grateful to the hundreds of volunteers, board members, dedicated staff and the very generous individuals, businesses and foundations for making our work possible. As Central Texas faces one of the fastest rates of senior population growth in the nation, it is even more critical that we continue our work so that ALL Central Texans can live their fullest and best lives without fear or indignity.




Travis County: 386 wards

Family Eldercare Guardianship Clients






Housing & Community Services

- Family Eldercare owns Lyons Gardens ~ A 53 unit low-income senior HUD housing property, in addition to providing Service Coordination to ten other properties.


