Family Eldercare was founded in 1982 by a group of professionals concerned with supporting the family's role as caregiver for frail elders through training and information. The agency soon expanded to include services to prevent abuse, neglect, and financial exploitation of elders and adults with disabilities. Almost all services that Family Eldercare offers are unduplicated, including: In Home Care, Money Management, Guardianship, In-Home Counseling, Service Coordination, Wellness Initiative, low-income housing for seniors and Lifetime Connections Without Walls.




