Meet Lana

Iris Gardens



June 18 was a historic day in Austin. Family Eldercare celebrated the groundbreaking of Iris Gardens—Austin's first LGBTQIA2+ affirming housing. Iris Gardens will offer 150 affordable housing units for older adults and supportive services that promote dignity, independence, and safety.

Amenities will include a ground-level fitness area and a large, multipurpose community room, a second-level lounge conference room, and multiple laundry rooms. Onsite supportive services will include service coordination and permanent supportive housing for residents exiting homelessness. For residents that identify as part of the LGBTQIA2+ community, Rainbow Connections—a program of Family Eldercare—will provide programming focused on promoting the well-being and quality of life of this community.

Did You Know?

Kicking The Bucket (KTB) is a dramedy fiction podcast (like an old-fashioned 'radio play') that offers a fresh take on elder care, aging, and end-of-life autonomy. A guided discussion with aging experts is offered after each podcast.
